Stationery Needs/School Supply List for 2011-2012

It is important for the students to have the correct materials for their classwork and homework. Students must have the necessary stationery needs noted here by the second day of school.

Grades K to 4 copybooks and theme tablets must be purchased from the school stationery school. Assignment calendar books must also be purchased from the school stationery store. The following items are NOT permitted for use in school:

All art and writing supplies should be kept in Ziploc-type bags. **Please make sure all materials are clearly marked with student's name.** All copybooks and student materials must be kept free of doodling, cutouts, stickers and defacement. Students are responsible for the proper care and maintenance of their materials. They will be asked to replace unacceptable copybooks.

The following is to be PURCHASED AT HOME and brought to school within the first week of school:
