As the weight of the closures begins to sink in I feel it necessary to update you on the state of vouchers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. While the House did vote down a voucher bill in late December, vouchers are still a living issue. As you may have heard the Archbishop has spoken out on the topic, "... They'd help our schools enormously. To put it simply: Vouchers are a matter of parental rights and basic justice."

As recently as this morning Governor Corbett, on the Dom Giordano Show, reinforced his support for Educational Reform, particularly vouchers.

Many have felt that because they themselves do not qualify for these vouchers it does not affect them. This is simply not true, as reinforced by the recent closures. When any student is assisted by these sources, it allows other resources to be more effective.

I beg of you, please contact your legislators en masse and demand that they not only revisit vouchers, but that they enact it into law.
